

Minutes of the Fifth Annual General Meeting of the Mount House Association held at Mount House on Saturday 2nd July 2011

The Minutes of the last MHA meeting held on the 12th February were amended: point 5 under Chairman's Business new members, Grahame Bartleet and Mike Greenwood were co-opted on to the committee at the last meeting. The amended Minutes were signed by PC on the 2nd July as a true record. Matters arising from the meeting included the following points:

- Notification on DVDs. MR contacted the Media Company concerned and DVD has been reedited. MR contacted all the people who received the DVDs in question and most DVDs have been returned. Updated discs have been distributed on the 2nd July: the total cost of the edited DVDs was £78.68 which included reediting and replacement of four DVDs. Action MR
- MR has the photo of Tony Wortham for the Wortham Hall: Headmaster 1957-1984. PC will finalise the potted history of Tony Wortham who built the foundations of the The School. A small paragraph will be produced. Action PC
- Committee members were encouraged to look at the boards for the Headmasters' and Headmistresses Board. Since the meeting, a board recording past Headmasters and Headmistresses has been produced and placed in the Main School foyer.
- The Governors liked the proposed location of the sculpture. Maquette from the company which went into liquidation will be returned and given to another fabricator for a quotation. Timescales and costs of the sculpture to be agreed. The other maquette will be returned to JE. Action JROM.
- NT has confirmed that the specimen tree for Philip Moore will be planted at the beginning of November 2011 or end of April 2012. Plaque will be arranged by Sean in Tavistock. Words to be finalised. It was confirmed that the cost of the tree will be between £30-£50. Action NT.
- It was suggested that perhaps another tree should be planted in memory of Geoff Whaley. MR will update the Friends at their next meeting on MHA events.
- MR confirmed that unique visits to the MHA website continue to rise from 3998 (2007) to 13659 to date. Page views are also increasing. Membership is up to 192. Leavers from the 6th Form this year totals 18 and parents have received a letter on MHA membership.
- NT suggested that a board naming unbeaten sports teams should be displayed at The School.
